**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

I. The Academy of Justice (hereinafter referred to as “AoJ”), represented by Mr. Enver Fejzullahu, Executive Director, with its registered address at Rr. “Murat Mehmeti” no. 1-3, 10 000 Prishtina, Republic of Kosovo, email: [infoad@rks-gov.net](mailto:infoad@rks-gov.net),

on the one hand,

and

on the other hand,

jointly referred to as the “Parties,” hereby agree to enter into the following:

## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

### **Article 1 Purpose**

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter: the “Memorandum”) establishes and promotes cooperation between the Academy of Justice and Kosovo Customs. Its purpose is to enable the participation of Kosovo Customs officials in training activities organized by the Academy of Justice, thereby enhancing their professional capacities and advancing their knowledge in the field of justice to better fulfill their official duties.

### **Article 2**

#### **Areas of Cooperation**

Under this Memorandum, the Academy of Justice and Kosovo Customs will collaborate within the framework of training programs organized by the Academy, ensuring the participation of Customs officials in training activities relevant to the institution’s needs.

### **Article 3 Responsibilities of the Academy of Justice**

The Academy of Justice shall:

1. Organize training activities in line with its training programs.
2. Provide training materials and resources for Kosovo Customs officials.

3. Inform Kosovo Customs in a timely manner regarding the schedule, location, and content of training activities.

#### **Article 4**

##### **Responsibilities of Kosovo Customs**

Kosovo Customs shall:

1. Nominate and send officials to participate in trainings organized by the Academy of Justice.
2. Ensure the attendance of nominated officials at training activities.
3. Collaborate with the Academy of Justice to identify staff training needs, in accordance with the Academy's Training Program.
4. Submit lists of participating officials for each relevant training activity.

#### **Article 5**

##### **Principles**

The Parties agree to implement this Memorandum in accordance with the principles of transparency, cooperation, trust, and mutual institutional respect.

#### **Article 6**

##### **Coordination of Cooperation**

1. Each Party shall appoint a contact person for the implementation and coordination of activities under this Memorandum.
2. The designated contact persons shall be responsible for institutional communication and coordination of training activities.

#### **Article 7**

##### **Duration**

1. This Memorandum shall remain in force for three (3) years from the date of entry into effect.
2. It may be amended, supplemented, or terminated by written agreement of both Parties.
3. Upon expiry, the Memorandum may be renewed by mutual agreement.

#### **Article 8**

##### **Dispute Resolution and Amendments**

1. Any dispute concerning the interpretation or implementation of this Memorandum shall be resolved amicably between the Parties.

2. The Parties may amend or supplement this Memorandum at any time, as needed, through a written amendment.

This Memorandum is signed in two identical copies, one for each Party.

**Article 10**  
**Entry into Force**

This Memorandum shall enter into force on the date of signature by both Parties.
